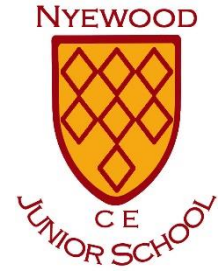

### **Question & Answer Session**

Further to our communication last week around a video Q&A session the schools have received very few questions in respect of our organisation and processes following the school reopening this term. We are pleased that parents and carers feel confident in the systems we have put in place and as a consequence there are few concerns.

For this reason, we have taken the decision not to film a Q&A session but have responded to the few questions we received below.

#### **Policing the one way system on site**

As you will see there are staff on the entrance to the school site and school playgrounds each day to support families in following the school one way system. We are also reliant on families observing this guidance and we are very grateful that this is well supported by our school community.

#### **Introducing a one way system on the pavements outside the school**

Unfortunately we do not have rights to introduce a one way system on the pavements outside the school however we would continue to request that families take a considerate and safe approach to enable social distancing both on site and on the roads around the school. May we please take this opportunity to remind everyone of the voluntary one way system on Amberley Drive.

#### **Before and after school clubs**

In line with current guidance we are maintaining our bubbles in school and so we are currently not offering any additional before and after school clubs which would compromise this. We will continue to regularly review this in line with government guidelines and our school risk assessments.

#### **Collective Worship**

Daily collective worship continues to take place across the schools in many ways; children take part in whole school virtual worship, video worship, outside collective worship and class worship within their bubbles. Daily collective worship continues to be a crucial and underpinning aspect of school life at Nyewood.

#### **Remote learning**

In the event of children having to self-isolate the schools will provide learning in line with the provision in school. When this is one or two children within a class or year group this will be provided individually for these children as a learning pack. If a whole class or year group has to isolate at home the schools are intending to make use of MS Teams to provide online learning for the children for the duration of their isolation period.

## School events

The guidance for schools is to limit additional visitors to site to only those absolutely necessary. For this reason we will be running virtual events in place of face to face visits where possible. We will continue to communicate with you regarding upcoming events and how they will be organised.

We would like to express, once again, how extremely grateful we are for all the support we have received from the school community. We will continue to keep in touch with any updates to our plans or if we need to make changes due to new or updated government advice.
