Comprehension Strategies

At Nyewood CE Infant School we use daily teaching of reading to develop children's skills in understanding texts. Our Super Six comprehension strategies outline each core aspect of comprehension in reading.

Connecting

I can use what I already know and connect it to new ideas from the text.



Visualising

I can create a picture in my head about what is happening in the text.



Predicting

I can use clues to guess what the text might be about or what might happen next.



Questioning

I can ask myself questions before, during and after I read.



Monitoring

I can identify if the text does not make sense and know how to check for sense when I am reading.



Summarising

I can think about what the main idea is or what important things happened in the text.
