Dear Parents/Carers

You may already be aware that as part of our Physical Education (PE) curriculum last year, children came into school dressed in their PE clothes on their PE days. As a school, we have decided to continue this for the next academic year. This will help to eliminate the time our children spend on changing into their PE clothes so that more time can be spent on exciting learning opportunities.

Please see below a timetable for when your child's PE days are and when they will be required to come into school dressed in their PE clothes. Please note, this timetable is initially only for Key Stage 1 children (Year 1 and 2 children). Children in EYFS will continue to receive daily physical development opportunities, which is delivered through class provision. EYFS will begin more formal PE sessions in the spring term and further communication will be sent out about this nearer the time.

This timetable for Key Stage 1 will begin on Monday 6th September:

A reminder that PE kits will consist of the Nyewood C E Infant School red t-shirt (or a plain red t-shirt if this is unavailable), black shorts, black plimsolls or trainers. We aim to do all of our PE sessions outside, therefore please do dress your child appropriately for the weather. This could include children wearing a hat on warmer days or wearing trousers and their school jumper on colder days. The wearing of jewellery is not permitted and must be removed on PE days. If earrings are unable to be removed they must be covered to prevent injury (e.g. with surgical tape). We also kindly ask that long hair is tied back.

I am pleased to say that we will also be continuing our outdoor learning sessions in our woodland area this academic year. As part of this learning time, children will continue to find out about their outdoor environment, have opportunities to den-build, pond dip, bug hunt and much, much more. Classes will have a scheduled time where they access the woodland area.

On the days where classes are allocated a woodland session as outlined above, children will be required to come into school dressed in their usual school uniform. In addition, children will need to bring in their outdoor learning clothes in a named bag. As these sessions take place whatever the weather, we would suggest that children bring in clothes that they do not mind getting muddy! Waterproof trousers would be wonderful if they have them and appropriate footwear e.g. wellies.

We are really looking forward to developing these aspects of learning for the children of Nyewood CE Infant School.
