We enrich the curriculum in RE through...

- Allowing children to show their learning through creative ways: role play, writing, drawing, painting, comic strip, playdough, singing.
- Visits from the clergy.
- Visits to the church.
- Looking at artefacts.

By the end of the EYFS children will...

- Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class. Make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding.
- Describe their immediate environment using knowledge from observation, discussion, stories, nonfiction texts and maps.
- Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.

By the end of Key Stage 1 children will...

- Know that Christians believe that God created the universe. That the earth and everything in it are important to God.
- Know that Christians celebrate Jesus' birth; Advent for Christians is a time for getting ready for Jesus' coming.
- Know that Christians believe in God and that they find out about him in the Bible.
- Know that Christians believe that by forgiving they will find peace in their own lives, with others, and with God.
- > Pupils will know that Christians believe in life after death.
