### **All children will have the opportunity to...**

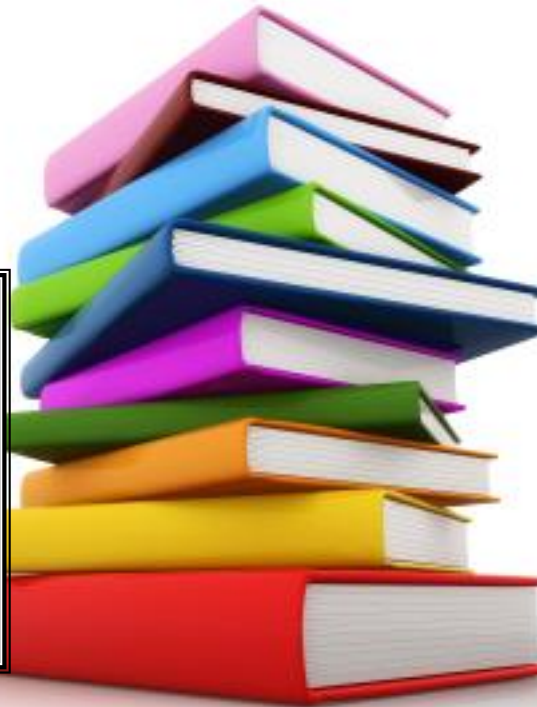
Interact with people who are experts or have experience of the past.

### **By the end of the EYFS children will...**

Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past

Comment on images of familiar situations in the past.

Talk about members of their immediate family and community.

Talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society

Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class

Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.

### **By the end of Key Stage 1 children will...**

Talk about changes within and beyond living memory.

Talk about the lives of significant individuals in the past and use this to make comparisons between aspects of life in different periods.

Use historical enquiry to research national and global events and events in the local area.
