LIBRARY UPDATES

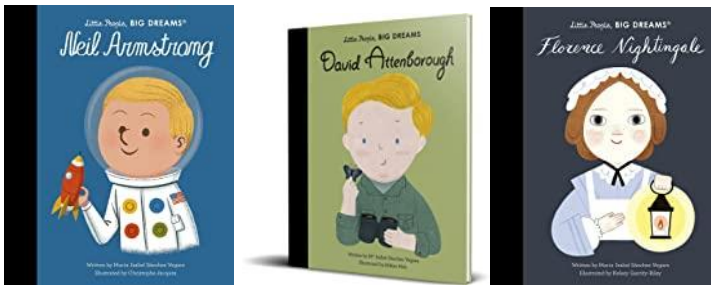

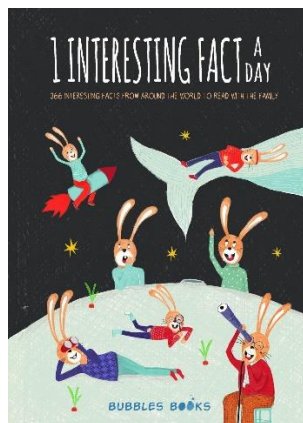
Plus the illustrations by Bethan Woollvin are incredible – using lots of neon colours to make the pictures pop!

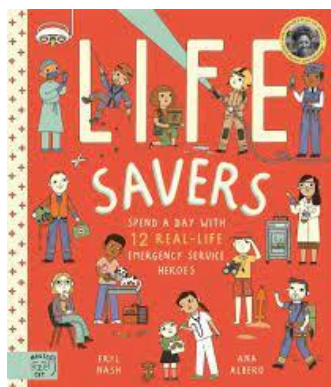
