Moving On Up

We will be spending the beginning of the new academic year welcoming back the children and settling them into their new classes and familiarising them with the rules and structure.

We will be using different traditional tales, as these are familiar to the children, to inspire independent writing.

We will learn about Bognor Regis and will write our own non-fiction books about where we live. We will even receive a visit from our local mayor. We also hope to visit Bognor Museum to learn more about Bognor.

We will spend the first few weeks securing the children's understanding of place value. This will include counting forwards and backwards to 100 and recognising tens and ones in 2 digit numbers.

During our wellbeing learning we will be thinking about friendships and relationships. We will think about developing new friendships within our new classes and how we can be good friends within our Nyewood Family.

For our learning during the first half term we will be using the text The Tin Forest to inspire our learning. Please encourage your child to create their own Tin Forest. This could be by drawing, taking photos, making with junk modelling or any other creative ways you can think of!
