We would like to offer the opportunity for your child to partake in afterschool clubs next term. Please note, we would like new children to be given an opportunity to start clubs next term, so if your child participated in a club this term that they would like to continue you will need to reapply.

### Brighton and Hove Albion Football Club

### Dramatis

Dramatis is an extra-curricular drama school that harnesses the power of pretend play. Stage stardom is not our end game. We recognise that not all children want to be in the spotlight – but do enjoy playing at being someone, something or somewhere else. We empower children's innate instinct to play by using drama games and exercises that turn their creative ideas into more structured stories. Rather than follow a set script, our pupils take great pride in devising their own unique scenes and performances. This creative process also helps children develop key Life Skills (whilst having a lot of fun!). Dramatis currently runs two classes in the New Hall at Nyewood Junior School on a Monday. Next term, we are introducing a **new after-school club** exclusively for pupils (aged 5-7) from Nyewood Infant School. These one-hour sessions will be a similar format to our current classes but we will be working with

Nyewood Infant School to have children dropped off to us directly at the end of the school day (meaning you don't have to turn out to shuffle them between locations!) Spring Term (themed around magic and mystery) starts on Mon 15 January and costs £94.50 (£10.50 per class). Book before 1<sup>st</sup> December and get a 10% discount. We are also running a FREE workshop on Mon 8 January (so children can try out a class before committing to a full term).
