This looks to be a great event where children can enjoy taking part in an Easter Egg Hunt, Hook a Duck, Guess how many sweets and Pin the tail on the Bunny. There will also be plenty for the grown-ups to enjoy with a Cake stall and the Hamper raffle. Hamper tickets will go on sale via MCAS on Monday 19th February and the online draw will be completed on Friday 22nd March, after the fair.

We would love the children to get involved in our Easter celebrations before the fair by creating their own Easter bonnet. They can make this at home and bring it to school on Friday 22nd March for a parade in school. The winners of this competition will be announced at the end of the Easter Fair.

In order to ensure that we have enough prizes for our Easter egg hunt we ask that you purchase tickets for this via MCAS by Friday 15th March. When you purchase a ticket, we will allocate you a start time during the fair for your child to complete the hunt. These timings will be sent out by Thursday 21st March, prior to the Easter Fair. If your child has any dietary requirements, please let the school office know so that we can ensure their requirements are met.

As you will know, in preparation for the fair we have 2 donation days. These are being held as outlined below:
