Dear Parents/Carers,

You may already be aware that as part of our Physical Education (PE) provision in school, children come into school dressed in their PE clothes on their PE days. This helps to eliminate the time our children spend on changing into their PE clothes so that more time can be spent on exciting PE learning opportunities. In the autumn term, we will be continuing this provision for KS1.

Please see below a timetable for when your child’s PE days are and when they will be required to come into school dressed in their PE clothes:

Friday	Hazel, Hawthorn

For all classes, this timetable will begin on **Wednesday 4 September 2024**.

The school PE kits includes:

- Burgundy polo shirt
- Black PE shorts
- Black Jogging Bottoms
- Burgundy Hoodie
- Black plimsols or trainers

Optional Extras:

- Burgundy Cap
- Burgundy Jacket
- Water bottle with Nyewood Logo

Please also be aware that uniform does not have to be branded and can also be purchased from supermarkets. Second hand uniform is also available from school. Please contact the school office for more information.

We aim to do all of our PE sessions outside, therefore please do dress your child appropriately for the weather. For example, your child may wear black PE shorts on warmer days or black jogging bottoms on colder days. The wearing of jewellery is not permitted and must be removed on PE days. If earrings are

unable to be removed they must be covered to prevent injury (e.g. with surgical tape). We also kindly ask that long hair is tied back.

I am pleased to say that we will also be continuing our outdoor learning sessions in our woodland area this academic year. As part of this learning time, children will continue to find out about their outdoor environment, have opportunities to den-build, pond dip, bug hunt and much, much more. Classes will have a scheduled time where they access the woodland area.

On the days where classes are allocated a woodland session as outlined above, children will be required to come into school dressed in their usual school uniform (or PE kit if they have PE on this day). In addition, children will need to bring in their outdoor learning clothes in a named bag. As these sessions take place whatever the weather, we would suggest that children bring in clothes that they do not mind getting muddy! Waterproof trousers would be wonderful if they have them and appropriate footwear e.g. wellies.
