Settling into the Nyewood Family

The children have made a fantastic start to school life at Nyewood. Starting their school journey is a big step for children and they have all taken it in their stride.

This term we have focused on the children becoming familiar with their environments, adults and peers. The children have learnt the expectations of rules and routines at school.

Reminder

Our Learning

Wow, what a busy term it has been! These are some of our learning highlights:

- ◇ We have learnt about seasonal changes in Autumn and created Autumnal art and explored our woodland area weekly.
- ◇ We have made decisions about what we would like our role play areas to be. We have been shopkeepers, waiters, doctors and teachers within our role play areas
- ◇ We have learnt about the Harvest festival and how Christians celebrate. The children performed a Harvest worship to parents, sharing some songs and art work.
- ◇ We have had focus texts including, Pumpkin Soup, Owl Babies, The Enormous Turnip and The Best Diwali Ever.
- ◇ The children have learnt their initial sounds and are beginning to read simple 3-letter words in phonics and reading sessions.
- ◇ In Maths we have learnt about the place value of numbers within 5 and subsidised. We have been recognising 2D shapes and using this knowledge to help us make shape pictures.
- ◇ The children had a visit from Paul Sturgess and learnt a range of Basketball skills, as well as a chance to celebrate diversity and our own uniqueness.
