As always safety is our number one priority at Nyewood. This month we would like to particularly remind our Nyewood Family member about safety on their way into school...

- As you know, our no vehicle policy remains in place between 8.40 and 9.10 and 3.00 until 3.30. Thank you everyone for adhering to this - it really does make a difference at these busy times of the day.
